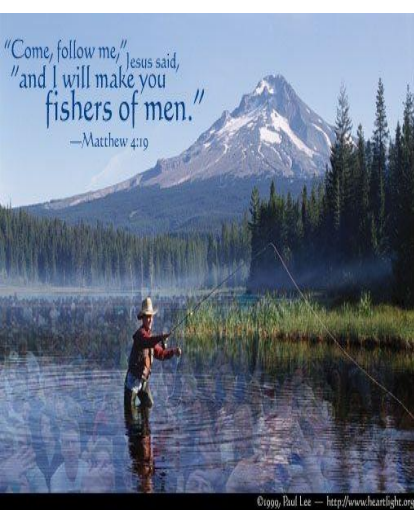


Thoughts From the Ministry Center

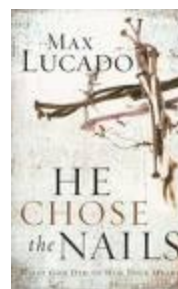
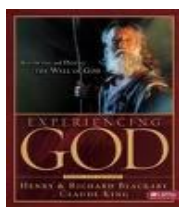
